Media Bulletin on Novel Corona Virus (COVID-19)

Date: 25 / 09 / 2020

1. In Union Territory of Jammu & Kashmir, **1218 new positive cases** have been reported since our last update yesterday, **642** from Jammu Division and **576** from Kashmir Division. Moreover **1478 more COVID-19 patients have recovered** and discharged from various hospitals **805** from Jammu Division and **673** from Kashmir Division. Also **21 COVID-19 deaths** have been reported **11** from Jammu Division and **10** from Kashmir Division (**25 September 2020; upto 5:00 PM**).
2. The Central Government is continuously monitoring the evolving situation of Covid-19 in the Union Territory and is providing all the necessary support in effectively containing the spread of Covid-19 & better clinical management of positive cases.
3. Claims under Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Package of the doctor from Pulwama & Baramulla and that of a health worker from Baramulla who laid their lives while fighting against the COVID-19 in the UT has been settled & payments have been made to the affected families. Under this package insurance cover of Rs. 50 lakh is being provided to healthcare providers across the country, including community health workers, who may have to be in direct contact and care of COVID-19 patients and who may be at risk of being impacted by this. It also includes accidental loss of life on account of contracting COVID-19. The insurance provided under this scheme is over and above any other insurance cover being availed of by the beneficiary.
4. For the residents of J&K, under National Tele-consultation Service, free general OPD services by Specialists/ MBBS Doctors have been started. People can avail these services from home by registering online on webportal <https://sanjeevaniopd.in/>. The services are available Monday to Saturday from 10:00 AM to 4:00 PM. People can also download & install sanjeevaniOPD app from google playstore on their mobile.
5. A 24x7 Rapid Antigen Testing facility for COVID-19 has been started outside the emergency of GMC Hospital Jammu. The facility will be very useful for the segregation of patients in emergency wing of GMC Jammu.
6. A 24x7 COVID Control Room for redressal of the Grievances related to the COVID-19 positive patients admitted in the Associated Hospitals of Govt. Medical College, Jammu and Govt. Hospital, Gandhi Nagar, Jammu have been setup. 7. People are informed that, the best way to protect themselves from COVID-19 is by maintaining physical distance of at least 2 metre from others, frequently cleaning hands with an alcohol based hand sanitizer or washing them with soap & water and following good respiratory etiquettes & hygiene.
8. As a measure for social distancing in public places & workplaces wearing a face cover is compulsory.
9. Early detection of COVID-19 can prevent the spread of disease, let us be responsible for the well-being of ourselves and everyone around us. Not disclosing symptoms could put life of

individuals and their families at risk. In case of symptoms like fever, cough and difficulty in breathing report early. Do not fear, call COVID-19 helpline No.s and seek medical advice.

10. Unless absolutely necessary don't step out of home, stay indoors. If you have to move out for unavoidable reasons, follow COVID appropriate behaviour, ensure that you wear a mask and practice social distancing, personal hygiene and frequent hand washing with soap and water.
11. In case of any emergency people can avail free ambulance services 24x7 at their door steps by calling on **toll free No. 108**. Pregnant women and sick infants can avail free ambulance services by dialing **toll free No. 102**.

Directorate of Indian Systems of Medicine, J&K is distributing AYUSH Medicines having immunity boosting, immuno-modulator, anti-oxidant, rejuvenator, anti-stress, metabolism regulator, anti-allergic, anti-pyretic, anti-tussive, bronchodilator, etc properties during the COVID-19 pandemic, the department so far has provided medicine to 9.59 lakh people in the UT.
14. Public is advised to strictly follow the advisories issued by the Govt. from time to time.
15. People are urged to rely only on the information released by the government through the daily media bulletin to print & electronic media. People are advised to refrain from spreading rumours and pay no heed to them at the same time.
